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#### Themes and topics

All our planning for the children is based around themes in order to engage the children's interest and give focus to their learning. We are hoping that you as parents will be part of your child's learning journey either by bringing in items for the thinking boxes or

sharing any skills that you may have that link into what the children are doing. Please see your keyperson for more information regarding what's happening on each day/week as we would love you to be involved. Next term the theme is families and the world we live in, the children will be looking at their families, making choices, stories and books and looking at lots of things from around the world.

### Meditation for Children

Meditation is used to rest the mind, body and spirit, this, in turn, has many mental, physical, and spiritual benefits. Studies have suggested that teaching meditative practices to children can improve their ability to pay attention, to control their tantrums and to make more considered decisions and



has shown benefits for attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), anxiety, sleep and behaviour problems. There are also physical benefits as it calms the nervous system and decreases stress hormones. This is something that we have recently introduced , the children are really enjoying it and are already seeing the benefits.
