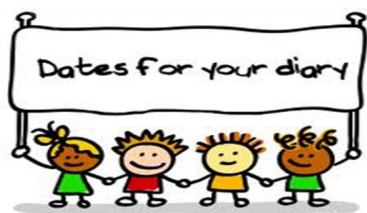

Please let us know if your child is unwell and will not be attending nursery.



Please:

- Ensure sun cream is applied to your child before you bring them to Nursery – this will give your child the sun protection they will need for the immediate session and inform a member of staff when dropping off that you have done this, If you do not do this we will assume that it has been applied prior to arriving.
- Send your child with a named sun hat on sunny days. You may prefer to bring in a sun hat and leave it in your child's tray. Nursery staff will ensure that children wear their sun hats when playing outside.
- **Do not** send your child into nursery in a strappy top or dress, their shoulders need to be covered.
