

Health Procedures – Disposal of Bodily Fluids



Disposal of Blood

Wear gloves and aprons at all times. Dispose of all tissues or cloths used into a yellow bin bag and to place in the yellow outside bin for incineration. Clean down the area with hot soapy water and paper towels again then clean the area with sterilising solution and paper towels. Wipe clean with a dry paper towel and then use anti – bacterial spray with a paper towel.

Vomit

Wear gloves and aprons at all times. Clean the area with hot soapy water and paper towels and then clean area with sterilising solution and paper towels. Wipe clean with a dry paper towel and then use anti – bacterial spray with a paper towel.

Diarrhoea

Wear gloves and aprons at all times. Dispose of everything in a Yellow bin bag, tie the bag and take it outside to the yellow bin. Clean down the area with hot soapy water and paper towels and then clean area with sterilising solution and paper towels. Wipe clean with a dry paper towel and then use anti – bacterial spray with a paper towel.

Staff to wash hands, following the Gov guidance after cleaning bodily fluids.
