Health & Safety - group rooms



- Significant changes to the premises, for example structural alterations or extensions are reported to Ofsted
- Where significant building works or structural alterations are taking place during normal opening hours a risk assessment is conducted to ensure the safety and security of the building is maintained at all times.
- Door handles are placed high to prevent children leaving group rooms by themselves or alternative measures are in place.
- Chairs are stacked no more than 6 high.
- There are no trailing wires.
- All radiators are guarded.
- Windows are opened regularly to ensure flow of air.
- Floors are properly dried after mopping up spills.
- Sand and any other items which may cause slipping or tripping hazards such as: toys will be picked up/swept up and where necessary disposed of to prevent injury.
- Socket covers are used.
- A risk assessment is carried out for each room ensuring that all equipment is safe and appropriate for each age group.
