Getting messy is an important part of nursery and preschool experience. We have introduced nursery uniform to give your children freedom to explore and express themselves whilst in our care. We have chosen a dark colour to reduce your stress over stains. We would like every child to wear our uniform which can be purchased at Barons.

Every child needs to bring a bag to nursery containing 2 sets of clean clothes plus nappies and wipes as individually required. Nappies and wet wipes can be kept at nursery if this helps to reduce your daily load

It is important that you understand what the nursery curriculum Please refer to the curriculum section on our website this will explain what your child should be able to achieve by the time they leave each room. Understanding what your child is learning at nursery will help you to reinforce this learning at home.
