



Clare House Nursery Two-Year Progress Check

Dear Parent or Carer,

This letter is about your child's progress check at age two. The check is a requirement of the Early Years Foundation Stage and takes place between your child's second and third birthday.

The nursery progress check is separate from the check carried out by your health visitor, although the two checks may sometimes take place at a similar time. If they are completed separately, please share your health visitor's completed evaluation with your child's key person. This helps us build a rounded picture of your child's health, learning and development.

Why your involvement matters

Children develop in different ways and at different rates. Your knowledge of your child is invaluable, and the check is completed with you, not simply for you. We will listen to your views, share clear information about your child's progress and agree any helpful next steps together.

The completed check will be shared with you. It will include your views and explain how you and your child's key person can work together to support their development. If your child is having any difficulties, has a special educational need or disability, or may benefit from additional support, we will discuss this with you and help you access appropriate advice.

Health visitor check

Your health visitor will also complete a two-year review around the time of your child's second birthday. After this appointment, please share the completed evaluation form with us so that it can inform your child's personal development plan.
